As from 1 May 2007, State legislation provides that all new applications to register a dog or cat will not be accepted unless the dog or cat has been implanted with a microchip (of which proof must be provided). This includes dogs and cats moving into the municipality from another Council. However, it does not include dogs and cats that were registered with Ballarat City Council last registration year (2006/07).

LOST TAG If your pet has lost its registration tag, a new one can be issued at the Phoenix, 25 Armstrong Street South or the Local Laws and Traffic Office, 115 Gillies Street South, Ballarat. A fee of \$2.50 may be charged for this service.

PENSIONERS If you are an eligible recipient within the meaning of the State Concessions Act (ie if you hold a Pensioner Concession Card) you are entitled to a 50% reduction in fees. Please note: Health Care Cards are not included

Please note: only animal name, description and registration number will be placed on the public animal register.

Where must I have my dog on a lead?

- Any public area where dogs are required by signs to be on a lead
- Within 50 metres of any children’s playground equipment
- Within 50 metres of any cooking equipment or tables and chairs in a reserve
- Within 50 metres of the high water mark of Lake Wendouree
- The Ballarat Botanical Gardens
- The Gong Reserve in Buninyong
- The Eureka Stockade Reserve
- Any strip Shopping Centre or Mall
- Within 50 metres of any parade, procession or organised gathering
- The Lake Esmond Reserve
- Any walking path or shared footpath

In what areas must I collect my dog’s faeces?

- In any park
“Park” means a Public Reserve or part of a Public Reserve that has been improved by the construction of a playing field, or contains playground equipment, or contains provisions for cooking or other eating facilities or has established and maintained lawns and garden beds.
- In a road reservation that contains a constructed footpath or maintained nature strips
- Any walking path or shared footpath
- Any public place that has constructed surfaces or equipment or fixtures provided for the enjoyment of the public
This includes areas like the skateboard rink in Mair Street, Council carparks etc.
