Microchip Identification

From 1 May 2007 all cats or dogs being registered with a council for the first time must be microchipped prior to registration. This includes animals transferring from another municipality.

Privacy

Council respects all personal and confidential information you give and will do everything possible to protect information from unauthorised access, loss or misuse. Information collected from you is required for the delivery of Council services in accordance with Council's powers, functions and purposes under the Local Government Act 1989 and other relevant legislation. It may also be used by Council to conduct research and customer satisfaction surveys so that we may better understand community needs and can improve service delivery

State Government Levy

Your registration fee includes the State Government Levy of \$2.50 per dog and \$1.00 per cat registration & is used primarily to fund responsible pet ownership educational programs.

Excess Animal Permits

A Permit must be obtained to keep more than two dogs and/or two cats per household. Application forms are available on the website.

Restricted Breeds

The following restricted breeds must be declared:

- Pit bull Terrier
- American Pit bull Terrier
- Fila Brasileiro
- Dogo Argentino

Pensioner Concession

To receive a reduced fee on registration you must be the holder of any of the listed cards below
Department of Veterans Affairs
Repatriation Health Card specifying a War Widow or TPI.
Department of Veterans Affairs
Pensioner Concession card.
Centrelink Pension Concession card.
Note: Health Care Cards are NOT accepted

Your animal not wearing their Tag
