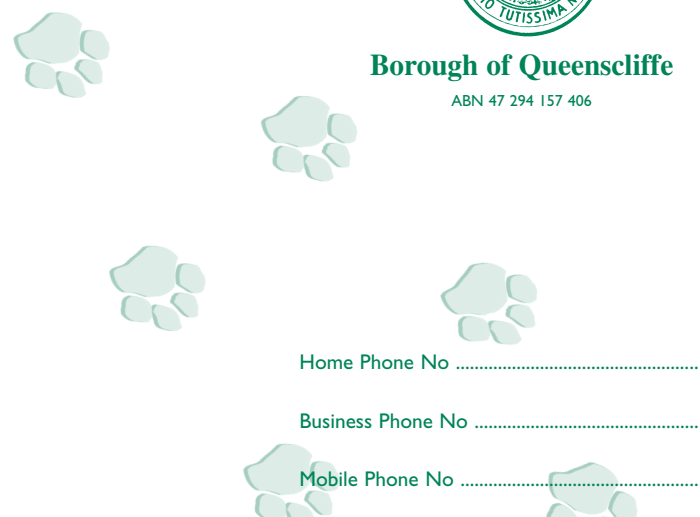

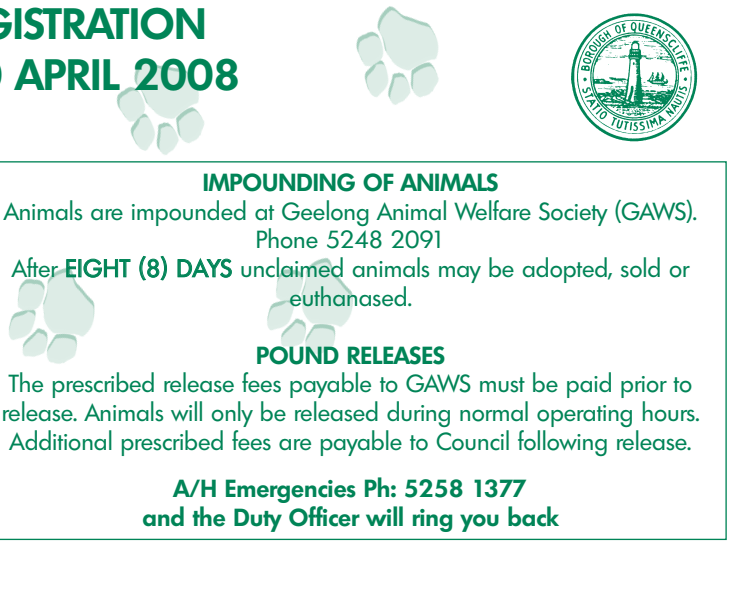

REGISTRATION

- * Under the Provisions of the Domestic (Feral and Nuisance) Animal Act, 1994, all dogs and cats over the age of three months must be registered and be re-registered by the 10th April each year - Penalty up to \$524.00
- * Current V.C.A. membership card must be produced each year.
- * Signature of Owner is required - if the owner is under 18 years of age a parent/guardian is required to sign the form.

IN PERSON

Please present notice intact to the Cashier. Payment by cash, cheque, money order or EFTPOS (including credit cards) at the Municipal Offices, 50 Learmonth Street, Queenscliff. Office hours are 9.00am and 4.00 pm Monday to Friday, except Public Holidays.

A receipt will be issued by the Cashier.

IMPORTANT NOTICE DOG OWNERS:

From the 1st November 2002, the Domestic (Feral & Nuisance) Animals Act 1994 requires specific control to the keeping of "RESTRICTED BREED DOGS". State Government has made legislation to restrict the following dog breeds:

- **AMERICAN PIT BULL TERRIER**
- **DOGGO ARGENTINO**
- **PIT BULL TERRIER**
- **FILA BRASILEIRO**
- **JAPANESE TOSA**
- **PÉRRO DE PRESA CANARIO**

By making payment of this registration I declare all details on this notice to be true. In particular, the description of the breed of my dog is accurate.

Failure to declare the breed of your dog if it is one of the restricted breeds above may cause you to be liable to a fine of up to \$524.00, or prosecution in the Magistrates Court.

Privacy Notification:- The information provided on this form is subject to Section 18 of the Domestic (Feral and Nuisance) Animals Act 1994 and will be used to update the public animals register as prescribed under that Act.

YOUR RESPONSIBILITIES AS THE OWNER OF A DOG OR CAT

- * Under new legislation proof of microchipping will be required from May 1, 2007 for new animal registrations
- * All dogs must be securely confined to your property and wear their registration tags at all times.
- * Dogs must be leashed at all times within the Borough of Queenscliffe unless being exercised in a designated 'off leash' area.
- * Your dog or cat must not cause a nuisance
- * Your dog or cat must wear the Registration Tag provided at all times, to ensure ownership of the animal can be quickly traced
- * If a dog rushes at or chases any person the owner is guilty of an offence.
- * **CATS must be securely confined to their owners premises between 8.00pm (eastern standard time) or 9.00pm (Daylight saving time) and 6.00am daily - Penalty up to \$524.00.**
- * CATS (other than restrained domestic cats) are prohibited in public areas in the municipality
- * All cats and dogs over three months must be registered.
- * It is the responsibility of the dog owner to remove and dispose of their dogs waste when in public places.
