IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Dogs and cats must be microchipped prior to registration, unless previously registered with Corangamite Shire *(this applies from 1 MAY 2007)*
- All dogs and cats over 3 months old must be registered with the Council in which they are kept. Failure to register may incur a \$214.50 infringement.
- Only 2 dogs and/or 2 cats may be kept at any urban residence without a Local Laws permit.
- If your pet has lost or destroyed its registration tag, a new one can be issued at the Shire office, 181 Manifold Street, Camperdown. A fee of \$2.00 applies for this service.
- The registration fee includes the State Government Levy (\$2.50 per dog, \$1.00 per cat) – which is used primarily to fund responsible pet ownership education programs.
- **Privacy Notification:** - The information provided on this form is subject to Section 18 of the Domestic (Feral and Nuisance) Animals Act 1994 and will be used to update the public animals register as prescribed under that Act.
- Please pay as per fees on reverse side, the Statutory Declaration must be completed for reduced fees.
- Please read the information on reverse concerning "RESTRICTED BREED DOGS".

Pensioners - if you are an eligible recipient within the meaning of the State Concessions Act you are entitled to a 50% reduction in fees.

To be eligible for the \$17.00 dog or \$8.00 cat fees (1/2 for pensioners) you must either attach a Veterinary Certificate showing that the animal has been desexed: OR complete the Statutory Declaration.

RESTRICTED BREED DOGS – IMPORTANT NOTICE

The State Government has recently made significant amendments to the Domestic (Feral and Nuisance) Animals Act 1994 in relation to the keeping of "RESTRICTED BREED DOGS".

A "RESTRICTED BREED DOG" means a dog of a breed whose importation into Australia is prohibited under Customs (Prohibited Imports) Regulations 1956 of the Commonwealth. These breeds currently are:

- Dogo Argentino
- Fila Brasileiro
- Japanese Tosa
- American Pit Bull Terrier
- Pit Bull Terrier
- Perro De Presa Canario

Please see the enclosed Notice and Sworn Statement if you are the owner of a "RESTRICTED BREED DOG".
Failure to comply with the legislation requirements may result in a \$520.00 penalty being incurred.
