IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Domestic (Feral and Nuisance) Animals Act 1994 requires that all cats and dogs 3 months of age and over must be registered. Failure to do so may incur a \$500.00 penalty.
- Renew Registration by 10 April each year to avoid receiving infringement.
- New State Government legislation from the 1st May 2007 requires that all dogs and cats newly registered with Council must be microchipped. This includes pets previously registered with another Council.
- The tag and registration number is for the life of the animal and is not replaced each year upon renewal.
- If your dog or cat is missing, call our Traffic & Local Laws on 9688 0384 (business hours) or 9688 0363 (after hours).
- Only 3 dogs and/or cats may be kept at any one property without a Local Laws permit.
- * Maximum fee applies for Dangerous and Restricted Breeds

REDUCED FEE CATEGORIES

You may be eligible for a reduced fee if your Dog or Cat meets the following requirements of the Domestic (Feral and Nuisance) Animals Act

D1 Desexed dogs.	C1 Desexed cats.
D2 Dogs over 10 years old.	C2 Cats over 10 years old.
D3 Dogs kept for working stock.	C3 Cats kept for breeding by the proprietor of a domestic animal business conducted on registered premises.
D4 Dogs kept for breeding by the proprietor of a domestic animal business conducted on registered premises.	C4 Cats registered with the Feline Control Council, the Governing Council of the Cat Fancy Australia and Victoria Incorporated, the Democratic Cat Council Incorporated or any successor in law of any one of those associations or a breed society approved by the Council.
D5 Dogs that have undergone obedience training which complies with regulations.	C5 Cats that are permanently identified in the prescribed manner (Microchipped).
D6 Dogs registered with the Victorian Canine Association or any successor in law of that approved by the council.	
D7 Dogs that are permanently identified in the prescribed manner (Microchipped).	

If you wish to claim 50% discount on registration fees, a pension card must be sighted by the Customer Liaison Officer or a photocopy of the card sent in with the application form. Persons holding **a health benefits card are not entitled to this discount**. Proof of categories d3 – d7 or c3 – c5 is required in the form of photocopies of relevant documents.

Privacy Statement

The information provided on this form is necessary for administration and enforcement of the Domestic (Feral & Nuisance) Animals Act 1994 and associated Maribyrnong Local Laws. It will be used to update the public animals register as prescribed under Section 18 of the Act.

IMPORTANT NOTICE TO DOG OWNERS

From the 1st November 2002 amendments to the Domestic (Feral & Nuisance) Animals Act 1994 requires specific controls for the keeping of "RESTRICTED BREED" dogs. The Victorian Government has made legislation to restrict the following dog breeds:

PIT BULL TERRIER, AMERICAN PIT BULL TERRIER, JAPANESE TOSA, FILABRASILEIRO, DOGO ARGENTINO, PRESA CANAIRO.

By making payment of this registration, I declare all details on this notice to be true. In particular, the description of the breed of my dog is accurate. Failure to declare the breed of your dog if it is one of the restricted breeds above may cause you to be liable to a fine of up to \$500.00, or prosecution in the Magistrates' Court.

PENALTIES IN RELATION TO DOG AND CAT OWNERSHIP

Failure to apply to register or renew the registration of a dog or cat over 3 months of age	\$524
A dog that attacks or bites any person or animal	\$1048 (The owner of a dog is liable for any damage caused by conduct of that dog). In addition serious attack may result in the dog being declared as a Dangerous Dog.
Dog that rushes at or chases a person	\$419 (In addition the incident result in the dog being declared as a Menacing Dog).
Dog or cat found outside the owner's premises without a registration tag	\$105
Dogs found at large (Wandering)	Daytime \$314 – Night time \$524
Barking/nuisance dog	First offence \$105 – Second offence \$314
Failure to secure a dog on a vehicle/trailer	\$524
Failure to confine a Dangerous or Restricted Dog to owner's premises	\$1048 – Restricted Breed \$524/\$1048
Cat on private property without permission	First offence \$100 – Second offence \$524
Failure to carry a litter device or pick up after your dog	\$215 (on the spot)
