Conditions of Registration

- You are required by law to declare whether or not your dog is a restricted breed (eg. American Pit Bull Terrier, Pit Bull Terrier, Dogo Argentino, Fila Brasileiro and Japanese Tosa.) Failure to do so may result in a \$500 fine.
- In the case of dogs categorised as dangerous or a restricted breed, registration will not be effective until you receive a registration tag from Council or its authorised agent (pursuant to section 17 of the Domestic (Feral and Nuisance) Animals Act 1994). A dangerous or restricted breed dog must be microchipped.
- Any dog or cat registered after 1 May 2007 must be implanted with a microchip; this includes previously registered dogs and cats that move into the Council from another Council.
- According to State Laws all cats and dogs aged 3 months and over must be registered.
- If your dog or cat is eligible for a reduced fee (see Fees table overleaf), proof of eligibility is required either by certificate from the relevant authority or by completing the Statutory Declaration overleaf.
- Subject to conditions of registration, if you pay in person a tag(s) will be issued on the spot by the cashier. If you pay by mail, a tag(s) will be posted to you.
- Please check that all details on the form are correct and free of inaccuracies.
- State legislation requires the owner to ensure that the registered cat/dog wears the tag at all times.
- Return the completed *entire form* with payment.
- Failure to register may incur a \$500 penalty.
